 approved across 235,000 acres of the Los Padres National Forest.
- ForestWatch is working to ensure the prompt removal of idle wells in the Sespe Oil Field and is
 working with agencies and local elected officials to stop the proposed toxic wastewater dumping
 plan. We're also preparing to mobilize against a new plan that could allow drilling and fracking to
 occur near state parks and beaches, national parks, forests, and wildlife refuges.
- Our Outdoor Connections program expands access to our public lands by reaching out to dozens of underrepresented youth and families. Through outdoor excursions, we engage new audiences that will grow to be future stewards and voices for our public lands.
